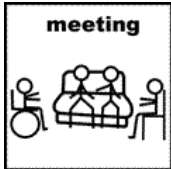




YPSF Meeting – 29th May 2007

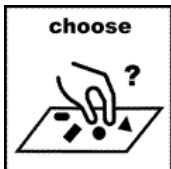

4. Christine Channon = Community Services Overview Scrutiny (CSOS).



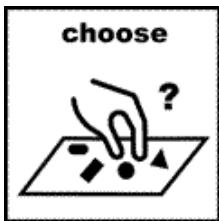

- Policing and young people- breaking the stereotypical mould
- Recycling- raising awareness- home and school
